Why Does Every Journal Require the Website?

- ➡ **Website** is the integral attribute of a modern scholarly journal
- ➡ **Website** is the «show window» of a Journal, the reflection of its' treatment of authors, researchers, partners and databases
- ➡ **Website** is vital for international databases
- ➡ **Website** is the profitable advertising place

Why Does the Journal need a Web-site Organized According to Best Editorial Practices?

-  International requirements to content display
(such as SCOPUS, Web of Science, PubMed, DOAJ,
Google Scholar, etc.)
-  Good for databases editors
(everything in its' places)
-  Good for researchers
(navigation and search)
-  Good for authors
(easy to cite)
-  Good for own editors
(subscription, statistics, DOI formation and registration,
online manuscript processing)

Obligatory Requirements

- Each article shall have its' own URL
- Each article page contains all necessary metadata – abstract, information about authors, references, full text (OA or non-OA)
- Each page with metadata is open and does not need authorization or payment
- Web-site is built good for indexation by search machines (such as Google Scholar)
- Archive is located at the separate special page
- Content of each issue is located at the separate special page and organized according to Best Publishing Practices
- Web-site consists all formal statements such as Publication Ethics, Access to Content, Authors' rights etc.

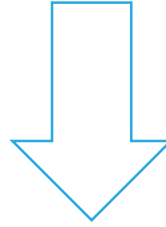


Except obligatory requirements there are special individual requirements of each database, which JournalCase monitors

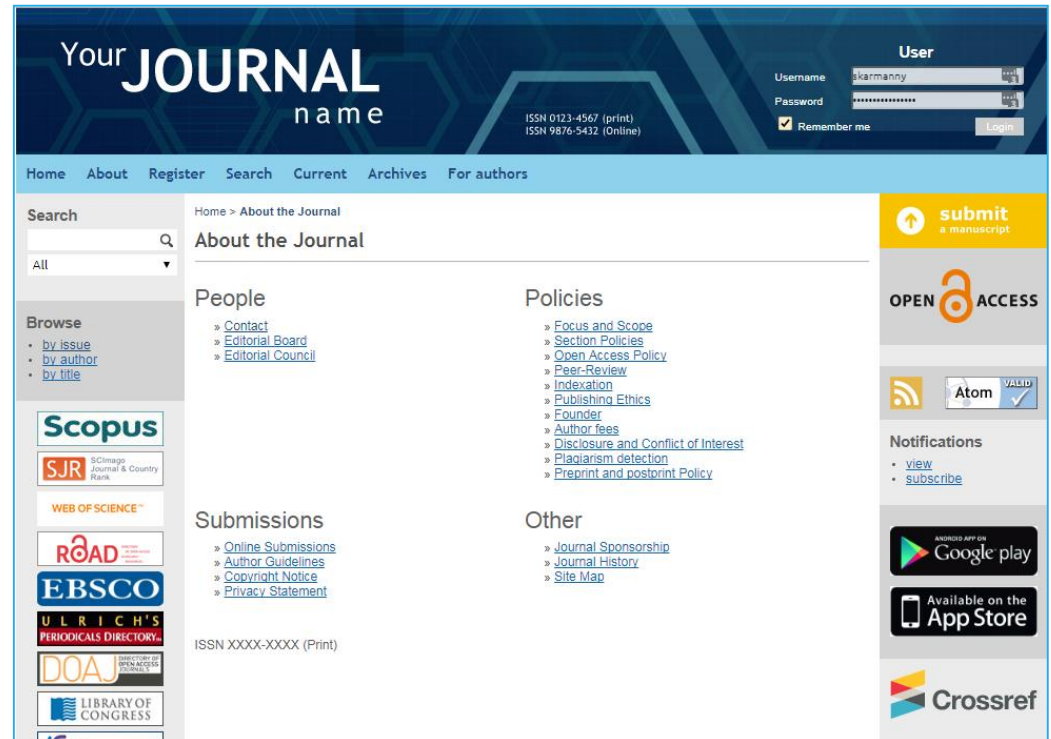
Search tips:

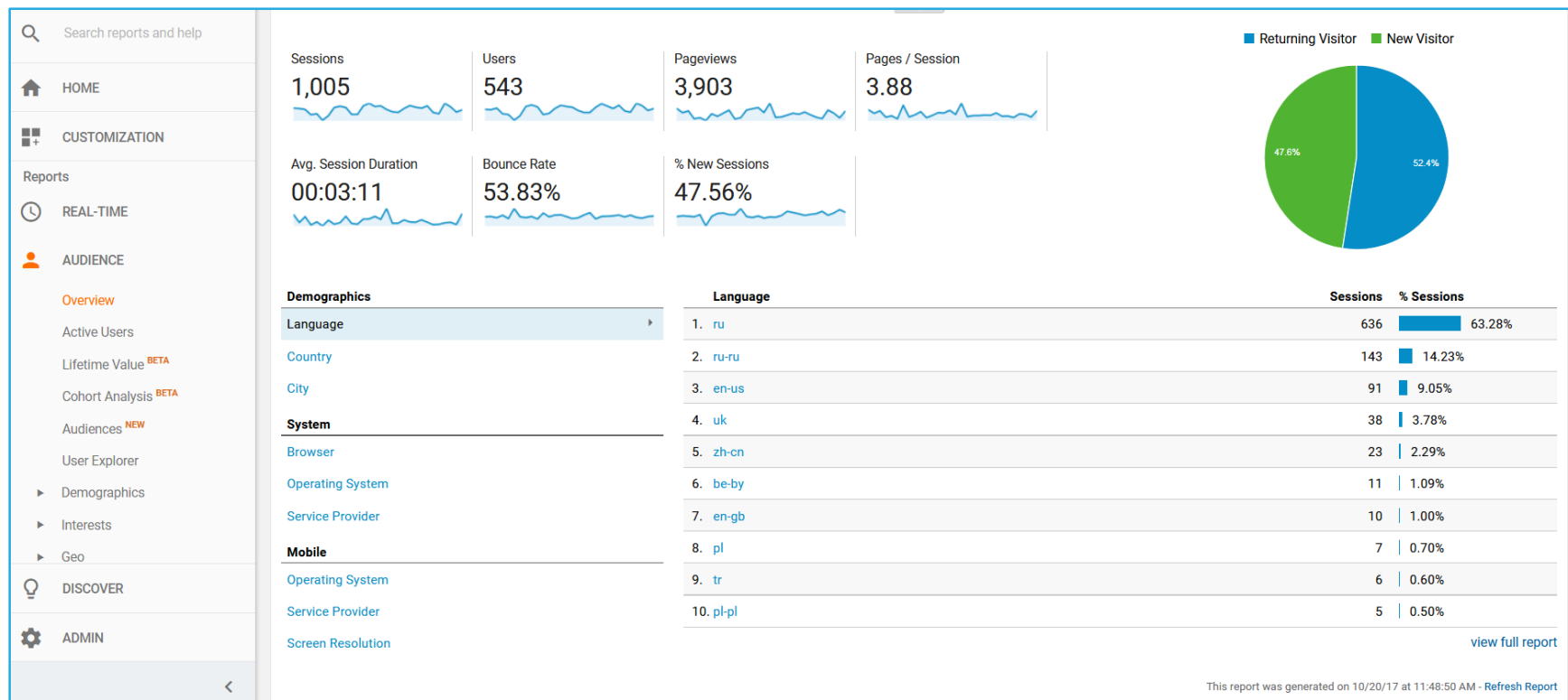
- Search terms are case-insensitive
- Common words are ignored
- By default articles containing *any* term in the query are returned (i.e., OR is implied)
- Make sure that a word exists in an article by prefixing it with +; e.g., +journal +access scholarly academic






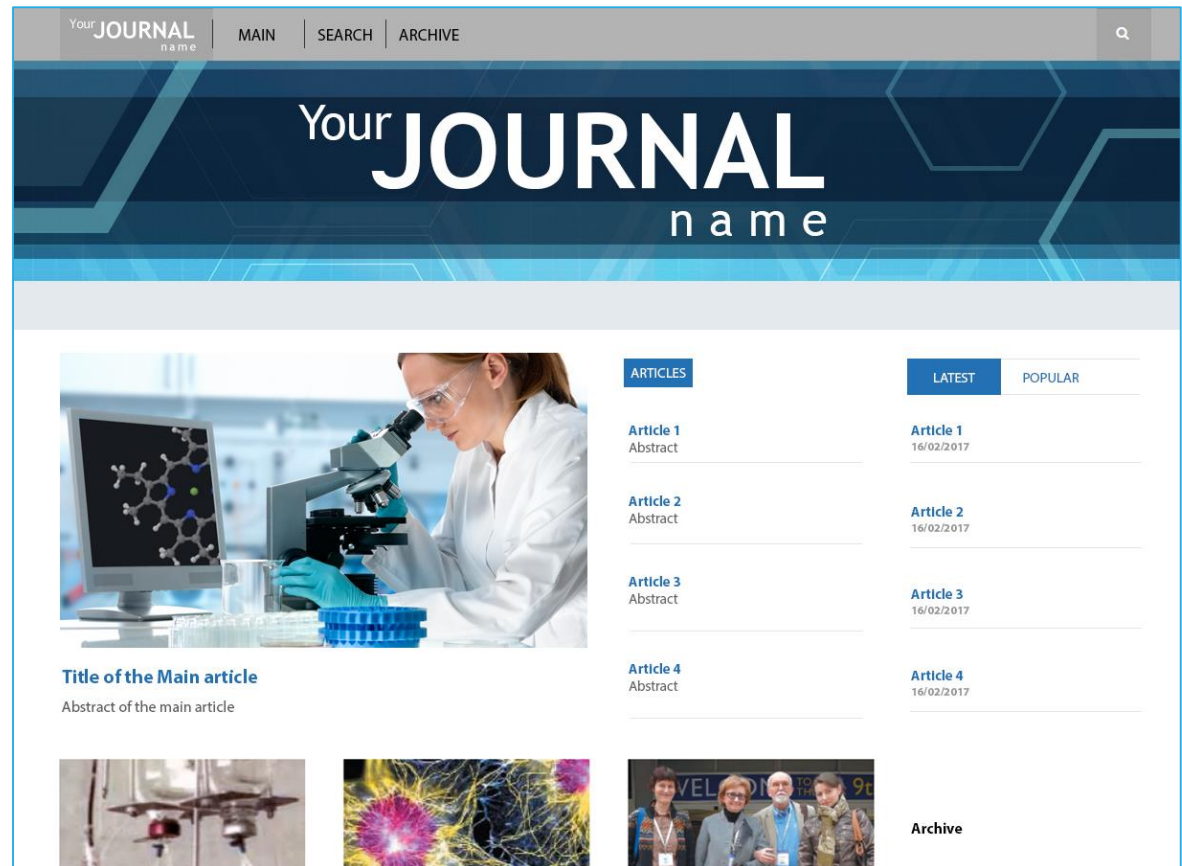
